A key component of the Humane Education Program is the provision of nutritious, **plant-based meals** during each session. These snacks not only support the nutritional needs of children from food-insecure households, but also serve as educational tools, demonstrating that plant-based foods are healthy, accessible, and often grown locally.



These meals introduce children to vegan eating in a practical, enjoyable way, helping them and their families develop greater food sovereignty and appreciation for compassionate food choices.
